

Salesforce Advanced Administrator Certification Exam Preparation Guide

What is the purpose of OWD?	Sets the default access level for an object (Private, Public Read Only, Public RW).
When does role hierarchy not grant access?	When OWD is Public Read/Write or "Grant Access Using Hierarchies" is disabled.
What's the difference between profiles and permission sets?	Profiles are mandatory baseline permissions; permission sets add supplemental access.
What are the types of sharing rules?	Ownership-based and Criteria-based.
What does Territory Management override?	OWD and role hierarchy for territory-assigned records.
Who can use Manual Sharing?	Record owners or users with "Modify All" permission.
What's the purpose of Delegated Admin?	Allows non-admins to manage specific tasks (e.g., user management) securely.
How is FLS applied?	Via profiles or permission sets (Visible, Read-Only, Hidden).

5. Lifestyle Tips for Exam Success

Sleep

- **Why It Matters:** Sleep consolidates memory and boosts problem-solving skills—critical for scenario-based questions.
- **Strategy:**
 - Aim for **7-9 hours/night** in the 2 weeks before the exam.
 - **Week Before:** Establish a consistent sleep schedule (e.g., 10 PM - 6 AM).
 - **Night Before:** Avoid screens 1 hour before bed; try a relaxation technique (e.g., deep breathing).

Nutrition

- **Why It Matters:** Stable energy and focus come from balanced eating.
- **Strategy:**
 - **Weeks Before:** Eat brain-boosting foods:
 - Omega-3s (salmon, walnuts).
 - Antioxidants (berries, dark chocolate).
 - Complex carbs (oats, quinoa).
 - **Day Before:** Avoid heavy, sugary meals; opt for lean protein + veggies (e.g., chicken salad).
 - **Exam Day:** Light breakfast (e.g., eggs, toast, fruit) 2 hours before to avoid sluggishness.

Mental Prep

- **Hydration:** Drink water consistently (8-10 cups/day) to stay sharp.
- **Exercise:** 20-30 min/day (e.g., walking, yoga) to reduce stress.
- **Breaks:** Study in 50-min blocks with 10-min breaks to maintain focus.

Day Before the Exam
